
Dear JoJo:

As Associate Dean and Director of Minority Affairs at Emory University School of Medicine in Atlanta, I am writing to congratulate you on your excellent scores on the April, 1998, Medical College Admissions Test (MCAT). You must be very proud of this achievement and rightly so! Hard work, preparation and diligence have all combined to lift your competitiveness for admission to medical school skyward!

We, here at Emory, are very interested in you and would like to learn more about you so we invite you to apply to the Entering Class of 1999. Our School participates in the American Medical College Application Service (AMCAS) of the Association of American Medical College (AAMC). Our School code number is #121. If you have already filed your application but did not designate Emory University to receive it, you need only to file a supplementary request to AMCAS. Following receipt of your file, our Second Stage materials will be mailed to you within three to five days. Thereafter, we urge you to complete your file *promptly!* Interviews will begin on Oct 2nd continue until the end of February. However, early completion of your file will allow our Committee on Admission, on which I serve as a voting member, the opportunity to review it for consideration for a timely interview; preferably before Christmas. Our Committee meets on a monthly basis to accept candidates who are then notified within twenty-four hours of our decision. Very often I call those who are accepted immediately following the close of our meeting. It is to your advantage to complete your application as early as possible. In another letter, I will share information with you about our *Emory Revisited Program* which is schedule for March 11-14, 1999.
