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

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Change & Cancellation Policy:

The "Y" or Executive Fare class is fully refundable. If you change the day of travel, you may be subject to any applicable fare increase. If you cancel, a refund must be requested at time of cancellation. You will NOT receive a refund on any portion of the "Y" fare purchased with the application of a non-refundable fare credit.

ALL OTHER FARE CLASSES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.

For all fare classes except "Y," there is a \$50 service charge per passenger per transaction to make any changes or cancellations, plus or minus any fare difference. If you cancel, you will receive a six-month credit with Vanguard Airlines, minus the service charge. For all classes except "Y" or "B," IF YOU DO NOT CANCEL THE ITINERARY PRIOR TO FLIGHT DEPARTURE, THE CREDIT WILL BE FORFEITED.

For "Companion" Fares, both passengers traveling MUST FLY TOGETHER. If one passenger cancels or no-shows the flight, the other passenger must buy a full-fare ticket to board the aircraft. If your fare requires round-trip travel, NO CHANGES OR CANCELLATIONS can be made AFTER THE OUTBOUND portion has been flown. If you DO NOT CANCEL the itinerary PRIOR to flight departure, the ENTIRE RESERVATION WILL BE CANCELED AND YOUR CREDIT WILL BE FORFEITED.

Gate check-in begins one hour prior to departure. A photo ID will be required at check-in. Passengers who do not claim their reservations at the departure gate at least ten (10) minutes prior to departure will have their reservations canceled and will not be eligible for denied boarding compensation. We do not transfer baggage to or from other airlines. All passengers will be limited to one carry-on bag and two checked bags. Weight and size restrictions apply. Each additional bag will be assessed a \$25 fee.

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
