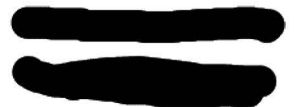

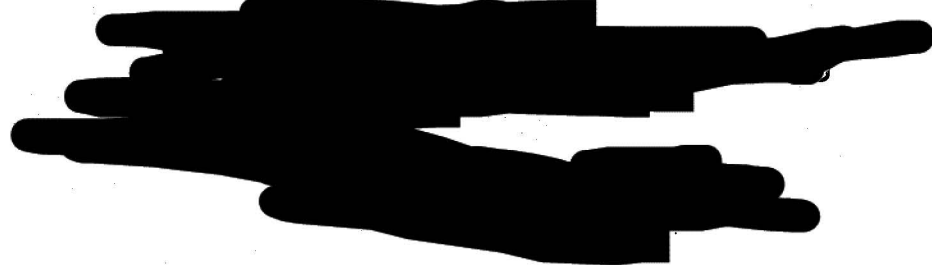
It is a pleasure for me to inform you, on behalf of the Admissions Committee, that you have been accepted as a member of the class which will enter our School of Medicine in August, 1999.
