
Dear Mr. Chokalingam:

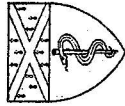
I went to tell you that
